A Hanney resident has been in touch to tell me about a very close shave recently at **St. James School** at drop-off time. Many cars apparently ignoring the double yellow lines, creating a potentially quite dangerous situation, especially when we factor in some very heavy rain that was falling at the time.

Please please take care, and if you normally use the hall car park but wanted to get closer to the school cos of the rain, well, I sort of get that, but would ask that you be extra vigilant and considerate if you do park near the school. And as my caller this morning rather succinctly put it... 'a wet child is better than a dead one!'

Meantime, here's a rather disappointing story about Thames Water.

(Warning...this is a 'head in hands' kind of tale.)

Yes, that's right, they're the folk who want to build a massive reservoir in our backyard!

One of their tankers is sent to empty a sewage pumping unit here in Hanney. These vehicles have a capacity of 15,000 litres and the nearest one available is in West London!

Driven here by an operative, who takes one load, but oh dear, the nearest treatment plants at Oxford and Cirencester are overloaded, so she had to drive her tanker full of our wee wee and poo - btw, should poo




have an 'h' at the end, or is that just Pooh Bear?' - to Basingstoke, a mere 44 miles away! She returned for a second run, but ran out of time to make a third. A rough calculation of her total mileage that day, assuming she took the tanker back to where she picked it up from, is almost

240 miles! And one of our specialist researchers here at Global HQ has dug out some bad news for all you green folk out there... these tankers do between 12 and 15 mpg, so at least 17 gallons/ 78 litres of diesel fuel burned in the process! The volunteers of The Flood Group were out though, trying to protect, as best they could, homes and facilities within the village. Without their continual efforts things could have been a lot worse. We should all the thank the Flood Group who week in, week out are clearing gullies and culverts and removing dead trees from the Brook to ensure the waters flow through the village.

We all can play our part; if your home borders a water course or gully, ensure it's clear... that's not just the responsible thing to do, you are legally obliged to do so

It cannot come as a surprise to anyone that the Parish Council have followed the likes of Henley on Thames and Oxfordshire County Council in passing a motion of No Confidence in Thames Water and their ability to provide safe water courses and sewerage facilities. Consistently, sewerage is discharged into Letcombe Brook and into our village. *Steve McKechnie, EHPC Chairman*

THE CHURCH OF ENGLAND



November is the month of remembering - especially on Remembrance Day and Remembrance Sunday when we honour the memory of the many who sacrificed their lives for the sake of our freedom.

Earlier this year we celebrated the 80^{th} anniversary of the D-Day landings, and next year we will be celebrating the 80^{th} anniversary of V.E.Day.

Perhaps the most extraordinary thing about the Second World War is the way it led to lasting reconciliation in Western Europe.

The following story from the Second World War illustrates this perfectly on an individual, personal level.

The story goes that an English Fighter Pilot engaged a German Messerschmitt flying over England, and got a direct hit. The German plane was crippled, and the English pilot circled round and came back to finish him off. He was about to fire his guns, when he saw a pair of bootees hanging in the German pilot's cockpit.

And he thought – why should I kill this man – he has a wife and children. So he didn't fire again, and as he turned away, the German pilot waved – thank you. And the English pilot noticed something strange – the man had a finger missing.

Many years later, the Englishman was in Germany, at a Restaurant, and he saw a man at the next table with a finger missing. So he asked him – "Were you flying a Messerschmitt over England on such and such a day?"

"Yes."

"Well I am the man who shot you down."

"More than that - you spared my life!"

"And do you know why?"

"Yes" he said with a broad smile, and took from his pocket a pair of bootees, which he had carried with him ever since.

The story doesn't end there. Apparently the two men and their families became friends, and one man's daughter married the other man's son, and they became grandparents of the same grandchildren.

It was surely the awareness of their shared humanity that made such a difference in this story. And perhaps this was what has helped to rebuild friendship between Germany and the rest of Europe since the Second World War.

Sadly in the Middle East today, deep hatred and fierce anger on both sides seem to be getting worse rather than better. We can only hope and keep praying that the day may come when the Middle East also can find reconciliation.

So we remember, and we pray, and however hard it seems at times - we hope.

Obituary Ray Woodyear 1930-2024

Ray Woodyear died on the 20th September 2024 in Ivvdene care home near Plymouth - he was 93.

Ray and Pat moved to their house in North Green. West Hanney in 1994, and lived there until moving to Devon in 2022.

Many people will remember Ray for his shock of white hair and for his role as the local Neighbourhood Watch organiser. He enjoyed village life and he and Pat helped with the Community Shop. They had many good friends in the village.

Ray was born in Barnet, north London, As a child during the Second World War he would collect shrapnel and even unexploded German incendiary bombs after air raids, and would use these to make his own pyrotechnics - something that probably influenced his future choice of career!

After two years of National Service he decided to stay on in the army.

Following postings to Korea and to Japan, he completed training to become an Ammunition Technical Officer, a role better known as a bomb disposal officer.



After leaving the army Ray worked for the next twelve years for Digital, an international computer company. He organised customer events, conferences and exhibitions in the UK. Ireland and the Middle East

He will be sadly missed by Pat, his son Clive and four grandchildren.

Keep up the good work Daisy!



Everyone is welcome to Join us as we come together to honor and remember the brave soldiers who have sacrificed for our freedom. This ceremony is a time for reflection and gratitude.

'Known Unto God' – Finding Lieutenant Wordsworth. On 14th Nov, the Soldiers of Oxfordshire Museum present the incredible story of how their volunteers worked with The Commonwealth War Graves Commission and others to identify the remains of an officer who fell in the Great War, missing since 1917.

Ingram Murray (father of historian and comedian Al Murray) will tell the story

of the search for the identity of an unknown soldier killed in action during the First World War.

The unknown officer was later identified as Lieutenant Osmond Bartle Wordsworth, a descendant of the poet Wordsworth. The soldier - a survivor of the Lusitania disaster



of 1915 when 1,200 of the 1,960 passengers died - he fell in battle near Arras, France.

The story began in 2013 when a local farmer, digging in his garden in the village of Hénin-sur-Cojeul discovered human remains which local police determined dated from the Great War. The body was that of Osmond Wordsworth. The evening, which starts at 6pm, includes a tour of the venue, Buscot House, Faringdon, the talk itself, as

well as wine and nibbles. Tickets are £45 with proceeds from sales supporting the 'Soldiers of Oxfordshire Trust' and are available now from the Museum in Woodstock, and from their website.

I rather like coincidences, and as the


US Presidential election happens this month on the 5th, I found these ones that involve past Presidents rather interesting but also very sad indeed....


